Introduction & Programme Overview

FutureLife-Now! is a regional school-based programme aimed at reducing new HIV infections and increasing ART adherence amongst young people in the SADC region. To achieve this goal, the programme utilizes three key levers necessary for behaviour change: (1) factually accurate HIV/SRHR information; (2) accessible youth-friendly HIV/SRHR services and support; and (3) learner agency that empowers young people to make decisions and take actions in areas that impact their lives. The important crosscutting issues of climate change and gender are integrated into all programme activities. MIET AFRICA is SADC's technical assistance partner, supporting SADC with programme implementation at the regional level and Member States at the country level.

According to the Southern African Development Community (SADC) 2019 *Synthesis Report on the State of Food and Nutrition Security and Vulnerability in Southern Africa*, 41.2 million people in 13 countries are estimated to be food insecure in the 2019/20 year. Comparing the 11 Member States that provided data last year, food insecurity has increased by 28 percent and is 7.4 percent higher than it was during the severe El Niño- induced drought of 2016/17. The impact of the COVID-19 pandemic has exacerbated food insecurity in Lesotho. The FutureLife-Now! programme will provide emergency COVID-19 support to vulnerable learners and their families from the 10 FutureLife-Now! schools in Lesotho and a component of the support package is food.
