



## **VACANCY | Registered Nurses**

### **Tshwane | 5 month contract**

MIET AFRICA seeks to appoint experienced Registered Nurses to support the Integrated School Health Programme (ISHP) in collaboration with the Department of Health. In addition, the successful candidates may also be required to provide support to the Adolescent and Young People (AYP) Programme as needed. MIET AFRICA is a sub-recipient of NACOSA, a principal recipient of the Global Fund Grant, for the grant period ending September 2025.

Successful candidates will be seconded to the Department of Health (DoH) in the Tshwane District and be based in schools or health facilities, with a mobile outreach component, as part of the ISHP team.

#### **Key roles and responsibilities:**

- Provide school-based and outreach health services to learners in accordance with the ISHP Package of Services.
- Conduct health screenings and assessments, including vision, hearing, oral health, nutritional status, and mental health.
- Provide health education, basic treatment, and referral services for identified conditions.
- Ensure the implementation of sexual and reproductive health (SRH) services, including HIV counselling and testing, PrEP, and STI management when working with older learners and youth.
- Support and provide adolescent and youth-friendly services in line with AYP programme priorities.
- Liaise with educators, parents/caregivers, and other professionals to ensure comprehensive care and follow-up.
- Maintain accurate and confidential records of learners assessed and services provided.
- Compile and submit regular reports in accordance with programme and donor requirements.
- Participate in training, team meetings, and stakeholder engagements as required.
- Promote and uphold ethical and professional nursing practices in line with SANC, DoH, and MIET AFRICA policies and guidelines.
- Operate within all additional/relevant guidelines and SOPs including those of the Global Fund and NACOSA.

#### **Requirements:**

- Degree/Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery.
- Registration with the South African Nursing Council as a Professional Nurse.
- Minimum of 3 years' experience as a Professional Nurse.
- Proven experience in school health, primary health care, or youth-focused programmes.
- Training in NIMART, HIV and TB management, and/or SRH is an advantage.
- Ability to conduct physical assessments and screenings independently.
- Strong knowledge of relevant legislation including Nursing Act, Children's Act, and the National Health Act.
- Familiarity with Batho Pele principles and the Patient's Rights Charter.
- Strong interpersonal, communication, and administrative skills.
- Report writing and basic data collection and management skills.

- Able to work independently and collaboratively within multidisciplinary teams.
- Driver's license and ability to travel between sites (advantageous).
